Copies of the Electoral Register are kept at post offices, libraries and by town and parish clerks, so a quick check to make sure your name is there would take no time at all. It's your right to vote, so don't miss out.

You may have attended one of the recent meetings held by the parish/town council and may have shown an interest in becoming a councillor. Nomination forms are available now and can be obtained from your parish/town clerk or from your district council's website.
